

PROTOCOL FOR SHOCKING WATERLINES

Citrisil™ Shock is the only shock treatment that is compatible with Sterisil's maintenance products. The Sterisil® Straw should remain installed and does not need to be removed before performing a shock procedure.

HOW TO SHOCK THROUGH THE STERISIL STRAW:

- 1. Empty water from the bottle, leaving the straw installed
- 2. Drop a Citrisil tablet to the bottle and add 177 ml (6 fl oz) of warm distilled water or high quality municipal water, depending on your Sterisil straw type
- 3. Wait 60 seconds for the tablet to fully dissolve
- 4. Swirl the orange shock solution to coat the inside of the bottle
- 5. Connect the bottle, with the straw installed, to the dental unit and run lines until the orange color appears in the effluent handpiece water
- 6. Repeat this process until all handpiece lines are primed with the orange shock solution
- 7. Leave the lines primed with shock solution overnight
- 8. The following day empty orange shock solution from bottle and resume operations

This procedure can <u>ONLY</u> be done with the Sterisil Straw. If you are using an iodine Straw, <u>DO NOT</u> follow the steps above.
