









## Citrisil™ Shock Protocol through the Sterisil® Straw

Citrisil Shock is the only shock treatment compatible with the Sterisil Straw.

The Sterisil® Straw should remain installed and does not need to be removed before performing a shock procedure.

## **PROTOCOL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. The Sterisil® Straw should remain installed while performing the shock procedure.
- 2. Empty the water from the bottle.
- Drop a Citrisil tablet into the bottle and add 177ml (6 fl oz) of warm distilled water or high quality municipal water to the bottle, depending on your Sterisil Straw.
- 4. Wait 60 seconds for the tablet to fully dissolve.
- 5. Swirl the bottle to coat the inside with the orange shock solution.
- 6. Connect the bottle to the dental unit and run lines until the water appears orange.
- 7. Repeat this process until all handpiece lines are primed with the orange shock solution.
- 8. Leave the lines primed with the shock solution overnight.
- 9. The following day, empty the orange shock solution from the bottle and resume normal practice.
- 10. Purge until the color dissipates and treat with Sterisil's maintenance product or an antimicrobial that is EPA registered for dental waterline use.

**NOTE:** This protocol only applies to Citrisil Shock and the Sterisil Straw. This protocol does not apply to iodine straws.





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
