How do you ensure your waterlines are properly treated after closing for 2 weeks?

Prior to closing the dental practice, ensure your office has up-to-date maintenance products in place. For any closures longer than two weeks, remove the bottle, purge the waterlines, and let them air dry.

SHOCK THE WATERLINES WHEN YOU GET BACK INTO THE OFFICE:
